Annual Report (2023-2024)

During the session 2023-2024 the following programs were organized by ICC-SHW -

1.Introduction of ICC-SHW to Students in the Induction Programme

Students Induction Programme of Science, Commerce and Arts faculty were organized on 16th, 17th and 18th Aug, 2023 respectively. The students were introduced with the role of the committee to create awareness about sexual harassment and to deal with the recommended punishment for non-consensual acts of sexual harassment within the campus. 





3. Students awareness program on the topic "Students safety in College Campus

On 12th September a student awareness program on the topic "Students Safety in College Campus" was organized in CL3 of the college. Head of Physical Education Department, D.G.P.G, College, Kanpur was Chief Guest and speaker of the program. Prof. Arun Kumar Dixit, esteemed Principal Sir of the college, Prof. Rajat Kumar Srivastav, Chief Proctor of the College, Prof. Pushpendra Kumar Tripathi, Coordinator IQAC of the college, were the guests of the inaugural function of the program. - 11. Avoid becoming inebriated and losing control.


The lecture was very interactive and informative for the students. All the students actively participated in the program and their queries were effectively entertained and justified by the speaker.

5. Self Defense work whop

Keeping in view, the rising number of crimes against girls in the country, it is important to provide self-defense training to them in college to ensure their safety and security. Self-defense training is a life skill that helps girls to be more aware of their surroundings and be prepared for the unexpected situation at any time. Through

the self defense training the girls are taught to become psychologically, intellectually and physically strong enough to protect themselves in times of distress.

Therefore, College Internal Complaints Committee against Sexual Harassment of Women (ICC-SHW) organized a Two day's Self Defense Workshop in collaboration with Shotokan School Karate Do Association of India on 11th and 12th of October, 2023 in the auditorium of the college.

The workshop was inaugurated by our Distinguished Principal Sir, by lamp lightening to Godess Saraswati ji. Chief Proctor, Prof. Rajat Kumar, Coordinator IQAC Prof. Pushpendra Kumar Tripathi, coordinator OF ICC-SHW Prof. Pramila Tripathi, committee members Prof. Abhishek Kumar Srivastava, Prof. Adesh Gupta, Dr.Geeta, Dr Rashmi Srivastawa, Dr Rekha shukla, Dr Richa Nigam, Dr.Pratibha Tripathi, Dr Nidhi Nagar, Dr Ashutosh Kumar Jha, and Dr. Kalim Ahmad were present during the inaugural session of the workshop. Prof Pramila Tripathi introduced the importance of constituting ICC-SHW in college campus and also briefed the functioning of the committee in the college campus.

Total 125 students were registered for the workshop.

The training was given by Shihan Vijay Kumar and his team, Vishi Kumar, Aryan, Pawan and Manasi. Mr. Shihan Kumar has 30 years of experience in the field self defense training programme, he is self defense expert, nutrition expert and has given self defense training to UP. Police (Crime Branch) and ATS Lucknow.

During first day (11th Oct.2023) tips and tricks for self defense were given to the students, in which it was suggested that how and where to use punch and kick forcefully to escape from any adverse situation. Mr. Shihan Vijay Kumar taught the students about, the Knee strike and suggested that it is a standing kick which is a crucial way when student gets adrenalized. He also told and trained the students about the attacks on sensitive places, strong fist, attacking postures, frequent punching, foot attack and a proper, defensive body language. At the end of the first day training the students were given refreshment.









On the next day (12th Oct.2023) Mr. Shihan Vijay Kumar trained the students for self defense by various methods. The students were given training for pranayam, yoga and physical exercises for being psychologically, emotionally and physically strong. Mr.Shihan Vijay Kumar introduced the importance of healthy diet, exercise, yoga and pranayaam to the students. In this workshop students participated with great interest and enthusiasm.

During the valedictory function on second day Prof.Arun Kumar Dixit, Principal of the college, Prof. Rajat Kumar Srivastav, Chief Proctor of the College, Prof. Pushpendra Kumar Tripathi, Coordinator IQAC of the college, were the guests of the valedictory function of the workshop. Prof.Pramila Tripathi, Coordinator of the committee and committee members Prof. Abhishek Kumar Srivastava, Prof. Adesh Gupta, Dr. Geeta, Dr. Rashmi Srivastawa, Dr. Rekha shukla, Dr. Richa Nigam, Dr.Pratibha Tripathi, Dr. Nidhi Nagar, Dr. Ashutosh Kumar Jha, and Dr. Kalim Ahmad were also present during the validictory session of the workshop.


6. Awareness workshop at DM office






7.International Women's Day celebration


8. International Girls in ICT day celebration

Number of grievances redressed to prove timely redressal of the grievances

Case 1. First case, ICC-SHW Case 1 was received and resolved in October, 2023. The case was resolved by following both the formal and informal methods. The final report was submitted to the employer ie. Secretary, Board of management, DAV College Kanpur.

Case 2. **Second case,** ICC-SHW Case 2 was received in June,2024. The case was resolved within a week by the committee by formal method.
