

Minutes of the meeting of the Policy Development Committee under Research and Development Cell held on 11.08.2023

Today (11-08-23) a meeting of the "Policy Development Committee under Research and Development Cell" was held in the Department of Botany, DAV College, Kanpur, to discuss the agenda and functions of the committee. The meeting was chaired by the convener of the committee Prof. Pramila Tripathi. Dr. Sunil Kumar Singh, Dr. Kumar Amit, Dr. Yateesh Dubey and Dr. Ashish Verma discussed the utility, functions and responsibilities of the committee in context to generate the research environment amongst the faculty members and students of the college, as required by the New Education Policy 2020, criteria led by UGC.

Members of the committee suggested that

1. Establishment of Departmental Research Committee (DRC) for monitoring research based activities of the department. The DRC have to work under the guidelines of RDC of the college.
2. For the motivation and involvement of students, research oriented activities like seminars, poster presentation, quiz competitions, tours etc. must be made mandatory by allotting marks to the activity at graduation and post graduation levels.
3. Students must be awarded, certificates and medals for the competitive activities (viz. Quiz, poster presentation, seminars etc) for motivation and encouragement .
4. Lecture series on research and innovation, either by the faculty members or by external members should be organised at regular basis during the academic session to create a healthy and interactive atmosphere among the faculty members and students of the College.
5. Pre Ph.d presentation of synopsis by the research scholars at college level is also suggested by the members of the committee.

Functions to be played by the committee

- 1.To organise research oriented lectures, seminars and workshops to guide and update the faculties and students for their dissertation and research work.
- 2.To encourage faculties to interact and involve with the students for their motivation for conducting different research oriented activities.
- 3.To encourage faculty members to apply for Major, Minor Research Projects and to develop innovative research ideas.
- 4.In addition to academic calendar of the college, a calendar showing the various research based activities, to be carried out by the students and faculty members, for entire session, can also be prepared
